

TRANS URETHRAL RESECTION PROSTATE

Home education

- Adequate fluid intake 2–3 litres per 24 hours, to ensure the passing of high volumes of urine
- Prevent constipation by taking the prescribed medication and eating enough fruit
- 3. Empty your bladder regularly
- 4. Refrain from driving a car for at least 3 weeks
- 5. Refrain from physical exercise/work for 3 weeks
- 6. No sexual intercourse for 6 weeks
- 7. Rest in the morning and the afternoon
- 8. Mobilise yourself both indoors and out doors
- 9. Complete medicine as prescribed

- 10. Attend your follow-up appointment
- 11. Do not consume sour drinks and food
- 12. Complications may occur such as:
 - Bloody urine
 - -drink enough fluids
 - -Rest
 - If it does not clear up within
 - 2-3 hours, phone your doctor
 - Retention of urine
 - Contact your doctor or phone The Urology Hospital (after hours).

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
