

DEEP VENOUS THROMBOSIS

Home Education

- 1. Your doctor will give you medicine to thin your blood (called an anticoagulant)
- 2. Medication to take home, must be completed
- 3. Wear circulation socks 4-6 weeks from discharge
 - Wash socks with soap and water
 - Dry, but do not tumble dry
 - To be put on before getting out of bed in the morning
 - · Make sure that there are no folds
 - Socks must be pulled up high
 - Use baby powder to assist you when putting on the socks.

Phone your doctor if any of the following occurs

- Changes in skin colour (redness)
- Leg pain
- Skin that feels warm to the touch
- Swelling of a limb (edema).
