

INDIANA POUCH

Home education

- 1. Maintain high fluid intake
- 2. Prevent constipation
- 3. Avoid lifting heavy objects
- 4. Avoid driving or being a passenger in a vehicle for 4 weeks
- 5. No sexual activities for approximately 4–6 weeks
- 6. Follow a healthy diet
- 7. WearTED socks until follow-up appointment
- 8. Continue with anticoagulant medication as prescribed
- 9. Complete prescribed medication
- 10. Encourage leg and chest exercises
- 11. Maintain daily exercise
- 12. Stop smoking
- 13. Continue with Self-catheterisation through continent Indiana Pouch
- 14. Stoma irrigation with 30–40ml of Saline will continue as prescribed by your Urologist

- 15. If pouch is leaking urine, make sure that pouch is empty and free of bowel sediments
- 16. If pouch is empty and still leaking put a gauze dressing over, to keep area dry
- 18. Attend your follow-up appointment
- Phone your treating doctor or The Urology Hospital (after hours) if any of the following occur:
 - Fever
 - Severe abdominal pain
 - No urine output bloodstained urine
 - · Abnormal wound drainage
 - Redness, swelling or offensive smell around the wound area.

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
