- You can continue with your normal daily activities e.g. driving, sexual activities, walking, exercise and travel
- 2. Drink enough fluids 2-3 litres per day
- 3. Take your medicine as prescribed
- 4. You can relax in a hot bath or shower if you experience discomfort
- 5. Rest when you can
- 6. If urine becomes blood stained, increase your fluid intake
- $7. \quad \text{Make sure you attend your follow-up appointment to remove the JJ-stent} \\$
- Contact your doctor or The Urology Hospital (after hours) if any of the following occurs:
 - constant, unbearable, persistant pain
 - · fever-like symptoms
 - nausea or vomiting
 - ${\color{red}\bullet} \ difficulty in passing urine$
 - if your stent falls out
 - if you notice a significant increase of blood in the urine

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
