

NEO BLADDER

Home education

- 1. Maintain high fluid intake
- 2. Prevent constipation
- 3. Avoid lifting heavy objects
- Avoid driving or being driven for 4 weeks after surgery
- No sexual activities for approximately 4 – 6 weeks
- 6. Follow a healthy diet
- 7. Wear TED socks until your follow-up appointment
- 8. Continue with anticoagulant medication as prescribed
- 9. Complete prescribed medication
- 10. Encourage leg and chest exercises

- 11. Maintain daily exercise
- 12. Stop smoking
- Continue with self-catheterisation and neo bladder irrigation with 30–40ml of saline as needed
- 14. Attend your follow-up appointment
- Phone your treating doctor or The Urology Hospital (after hours) if any of the following occurs:
 - Fever
 - Severe abdominal pain
 - No urine output bloodstained urine
 - Abnormal wound drainage
 - Redness, swelling or offensive smell around the wound area.

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
