

SUPRA PUBIC CATHETER

Home education

- 1. Supra pubic catheter to be anchored on the supra pubic site
- 2. Wash the area with soup and water
- 3. Keep the area dry
- 4. Only on doctors request, apply prescribed ointment around insertion site
- Supra pubic catheter to be changed every 3 months either by your Urologist or General Practitioner
- 6. Maintain a high fluid intake
- 7. Avoid constipation
- 8. Continue with medication as prescribed by your doctor
- If any bleeding from insertion area, excessive leakage or blockage of urine occurs, phone your doctor, or The Urology Hospital (after hours)
- 10. Book a follow up appointment as needed.
