

TRANSRECTAL ULTRASOUND - GUIDED PROSTATE BIOPSY

Home education

- Following the biopsy, do not perform any activity that requires heavy lifting or straining. You may resume your normal activities the day after the biopsy
- 2. You may see a small amount of blood in your urine and/or semen and when you have a bowel movement (from rectal bleeding) for several days after the biopsy. It helps to drink plenty of liquids (at least 8 glasses per day) for 1 to 2 days to clear your urine. You may see blood in your semen for up to 6 weeks.
- If you experience fever, chills, fatigue, difficulty urinating or if the bleeding gets worse, contact your urologist immediately.
- It will take approximately one week to get results from the laboratory.
 Please phone your docter's rooms to confirm a follow-up appointment for your results.
